God, like a mother you are both tender with your children and fierce on our behalf. Thank you for modeling motherly love for us all.

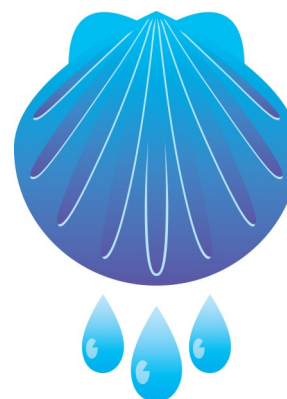
