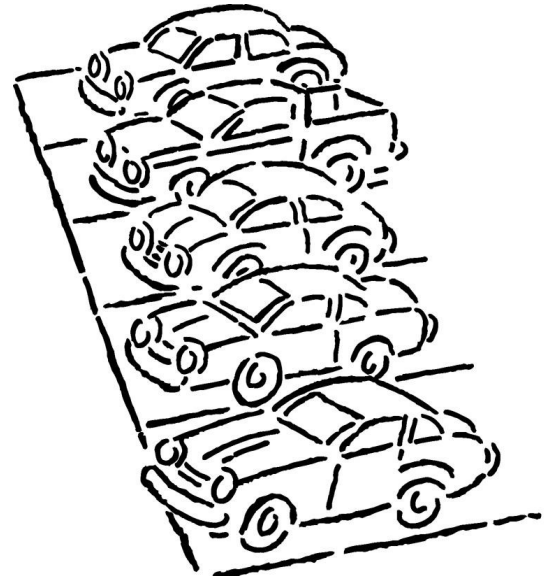

**June 2020 Stewardship Snippets****June 7, 2020 (Trinity Sunday)**

**Matthew 28:19-20** – “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

*Jesus completes his ministry with a lesson in community organizing. Disciples are sent to make more disciples. This work happens best in community where Christ is truly present, a community called church.*

**June 14, 2020 (Second Sunday after Pentecost)**

**Matthew 9:37-38** – Then [Jesus] said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”

*How will our faith communities look when we finally emerge from our sheltering in place?*

*Many things will have changed, but the good news is eternal. We listen to Jesus, pray for renewal, and trust that God is doing a new thing with, among, and through us.*

**June 21, 2020 (Third Sunday after Pentecost)**

**Matthew 10:39** – “Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it.”

*Sometimes community feels like loss, smells like sorrow, and loudly laments what is no longer.*

*Jesus proclaims a “kindom” community born of an essential loss to self. That death, in turn, enriches the soil from which the abundant life God desires for all creation will burgeon.*

**June 28, 2020 (Fourth Sunday after Pentecost)**

**Matthew 10:40** – “Whoever welcomes you welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me.”

You don’t have to watch hours of Martha Stewart to master the art of hospitality. Just fling wide the door. Community forms and flourishes in the soil of wide welcome and presence (i.e. hospitality). How will a new reality reform both your hospitality and community?
