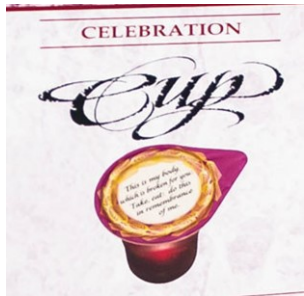

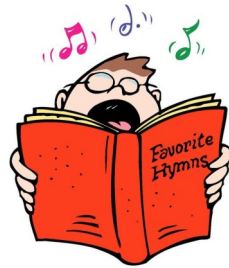
Welcome to Zion!

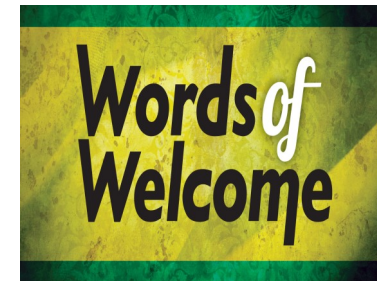
CHRISTIAN SYMBOL



THREE INTERWOVEN CIRCLES—Each circle in this symbol represents one of the Persons of the Holy Trinity — the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The circles, having no beginning and no end, signify the Trinity's eternal nature. The circles' interlacing symbolizes unity. In the center is a triangle, an ancient symbol of the Trinity.



As God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit dwell together in relationship, all of us who are part of this church community dwell in relationship. Holy Trinity, please strengthen us in love for one another.
