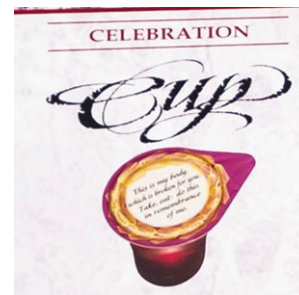

Noisy Offering:



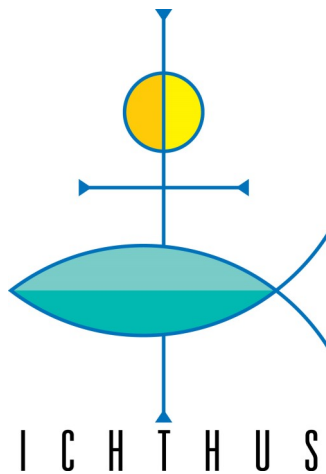
