There is **an urgent need** for someone to replace Margi Butts as the Meals On Wheels Chairperson as she is leaving the position on September 1, 2022. The ministry is valuable as it provides meals for approximately 20 Senior Citizens in the Newville Area.

Margi has characterized this volunteer position as requiring 0 to 4 hours a week. There is a MOW Committee but all communication is currently done by email. The MOW Chairperson oversees those who schedule the drivers for the three current routes, interacts with Green Ridge Village who is the current provider of the meals, fields requests from potential new clients, and coordinates temporary stops or changes for current clients.
