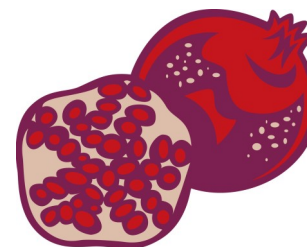


God who labors and rests, thank you for giving us this rhythm for life. During this worship service, I rest in you.
